Dear Community, Reports

In a previous newsletter we pointed out that if your child rates a 'C' in their July report that it was a matter to CELEBRATE. **'C' is a great achievement.** This week, we will look at some of the other ratings:

What if my child is rated 'D'?

1. Your child is working towards (approaching) the standard expected at their year/grade level.
2. Talk to their teacher about what is happening to support your child at school and what you can do to help at home.

What if my child is rated 'E'?

1. Your child is finding learning difficult and is receiving a lot of help already.
2. We know they are trying really hard.
3. Your child's teacher has talked to you about your child's difficulties so this will not be a surprise to you.
4. Your child is working as part of the whole class, in small groups and sometimes one on one with an adult. Their program is designed to match their level of learning.
